1. AENA rules apply.
2. At the start of each game the umpire will blow their whistle to start the game after the central bell has rung. Games will be 6 minutes each way with a straight turnaround. All games will finish on the central bell.
3. No 'time' is allowed for stoppages.
4. Substitutes will only be allowed at the discretion of the umpires in the case of injury, or the management committee in other cases, during the game. Umpires must ensure that substitutions due to injuries are made as quickly as possible.
5. Each team may have a maximum of 9 players. Players may only play for other teams, at the discretion of the tournament referee.
6. Captains to toss for centre pass before each game is due to start.
7. Points awarded will be 2 for a win, 1 for a draw, 0 for a loss.
8. In the event of a tie on points a 'shoot off' will take place with all 7 members of the team taking a shot at goal from a selected position. The team scoring the most goals will be adjudged the winner. Should the 'shoot off' result in a draw, then a 'sudden death' competition will take place.
9. Teams will need to provide an umpire who will umpire the game normally following the one in which their team has just played. NB the team playing last in the order of play must therefore be ready to umpire the first game of the day.
10. In the event of any unforeseen circumstances arising on the day, all teams must abide by the decision of the tournament referee.
11. All rally competitions are open to teams in the Acton League only, but guest teams can play at the invitation of the Executive Committee.

NB Any entrants failing to provide a team for any Rally or Competition after their entry has been accepted may be suspended from entering any Rally/Competition for the rest of the current and following season. Format may change depending on number of entries.
